



Bushfire safety

Under the Education and Care Services National Regulations 2011 (regulations 168, 169 & 97), approved providers of services are required to prepare emergency and evacuation procedures based on a risk assessment that identifies potential emergencies relevant to their service. If your education and care service is located in a bushfire prone area, or is in or near bushland, there is a real risk of bushfire impacting your service's children, staff, buildings and grounds.

If your service has not recently done so, the Education and Early Childhood Services Registration and Standards Board of South Australia recommends reviewing and updating your bushfire management policies and procedures. Where required, further advice or assistance may be sought from your regional bushfire coordinator and your CFS bushfire prevention officer.

Department for Education and Child Development (DECD) services and those services located on a DECD site must follow the DECD policies and procedures for bushfire management. It is the responsibility of family day care services sponsored by DECD to develop their own bushfire action plan.
